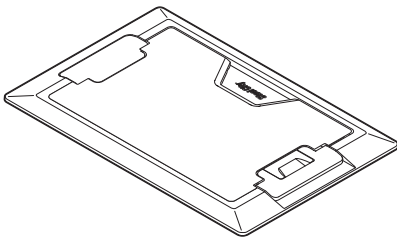

### 664-CST METALLIC SERIES COVERS:

- For use on 664 Series Floor Boxes
- Factory installed on AFM-2 Series access floor modules.

### 665-CST METALLIC SERIES COVERS:

- For use on 665 Series Floor Boxes
- Factory installed on AFM-4 Series access floor modules.

### Installation guide:

1. Trim Floor covering to dimension
  - Figure 1a - Wood or Tile floor trim.
  - Figure 1b - Carpet trim.
2. Apply clear silicone sealant as shown:
  - Figure 2a for wood or tile floor covering.
  - Figure 2b for carpet floor covering.
3. Lift CST lid and lay to the side. Insert screws and O-rings through cover into threaded holes in metal floor box. Turn screws until heads and O-rings make contact with the Cover. To secure, tighten screws 1½ turns (see Figure 3).

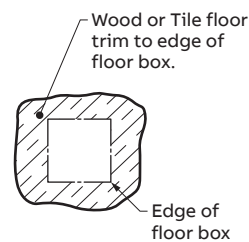


Figure 1a - Wood or Tile floor

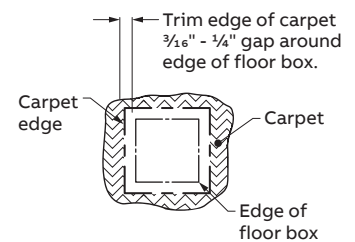


Figure 1b - Carpet

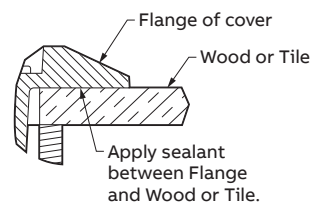


Figure 2a - Wood or Tile floor

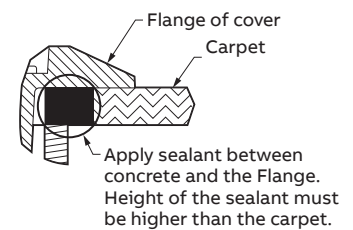


Figure 2b - Carpet

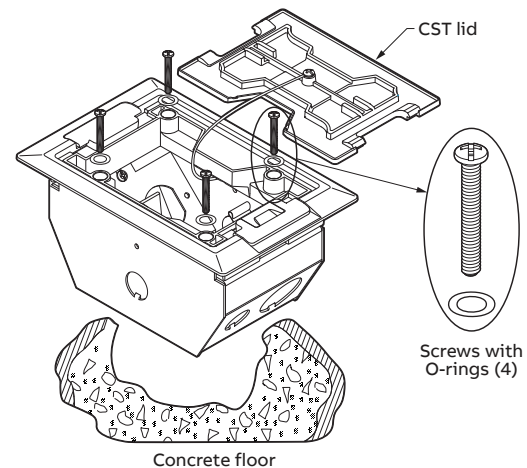

**Application guide:****Procedures for using metallic covers****A. Using the cover with cords:**

1. Pull Latch out away from CST lid. CST Lid will pop up (Figure 4).
2. Lift CST lid and lay to the side (Figure 5).
3. Plug in cords/cables as needed and route over cord ramp. Rotate CST lid around, so that cord slot is located directly over cord ramp and the cords/cables (Figure 6).
4. Insert CST lid tab into slot of the cover flange (Figure 7) to close lid. Make certain cords/cables are within the cord slot (Figures 6 and 7).
5. Push end of CST lid down and back against latch to snap into place (Figure 7). Use care to prevent CST lid from pinching fingers.

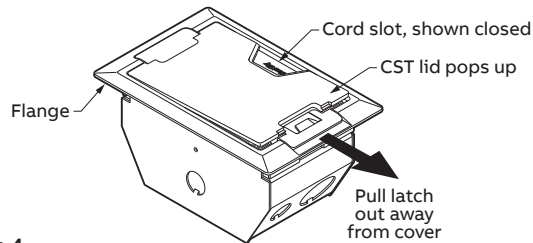

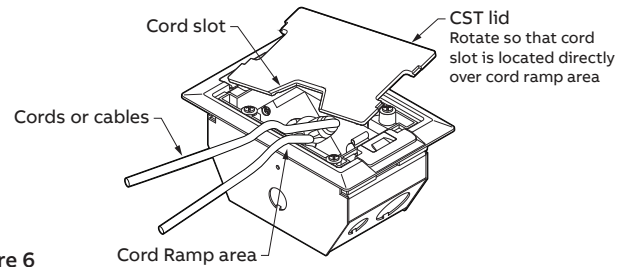

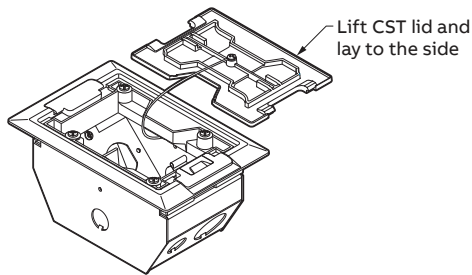

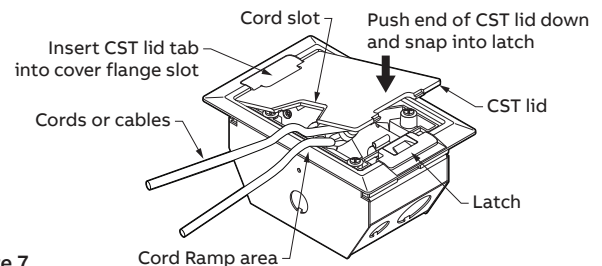

**B. Closing the cover without cords or cables:**

1. Follow Steps 1 and 2 in Procedure A.
2. Unplug and remove all cords/cables. Rotate cover around so that cord slot feature of the CST Lid is positioned over the seal cap.
3. Follow Steps 4 and 5 in Procedure A (See Figure 8).

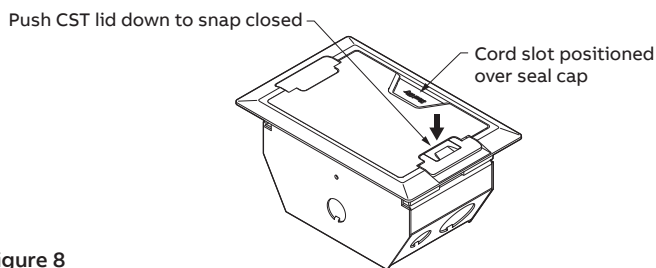
